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ABSTRACT

The objective of this study was aim to know the correlation between students habit in watching english movie (X) and vocabulary mastery (Y) by seventh grade students of SMP Muhammadiyah 1 Palembang. There were 62 students from 89 students took as sample of this study who were determined by using purposive sampling technique. The data was analyzed by using Pearson Product Moment Correlation and the instruments used vocabulary mastery test and questionnaire of students habit in watching English movie. Subsequently, the researcher indicated that there was high correlation between students habit in watching English movie and vocabulary mastery. It proved by the r (0.964) which higher than r table (0.213). it concludes that, there was high correlation between students habit in watching English movie and vocabulary mastery of Seventh Grade of SMP Muhammadiyah 1 Palembang.

Moreover, there are so many components of this languagethatmustbemastered; one of them is vocabulary. The absence of matery of vocabulary is one fundamentalissue.

Krashen,(1985)statedthatvocabularyisthebasisofcommunication. It means that vocabulary plays an important role incommunication, so we cannot be able to communicate well withoutsufficientvocabulary. Aminatun & Oktaviani (2019) states that by comprehending vocabulary, it will be easier for people when they want to say something in a foreign language.

According to Zeeshan & Khan (2020), learning a foreign language is an integrated process in that the learner should study the four basic skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. From the four basic skills, vocabulary is one of the language aspects and it is the most important component of language as a communication tool and needs to be mastered by the students.

Sabouri & Zohra bi (2015) states that films provide an invaluable extension of what we might call the technologies of language acquisition that have been used to teach students the basics of English learning in elementary and highs chool or institute.

According to Eva & Mira (2018), the movie is a moving picturethat is taken by the camera for the cinema, and the TV. The somethingentertaining and also projected on ascreen that combines astory, scenes, history, incident and also music. Sadiman (2009), states that amovie also is an effective medium in the teaching-learning process

because it stimulates students with both receptive skills (listening andreading) and productive skills (speaking and writing) by seeing thepictureandlearningtheaudio.

According to Pratiwi & Ayu (2020), watching English movies, especially with English subtitles, will enhance vocabulary and speakingskills. Ebrahimi & Bazaee (2016) states that the use of movie subtitlehas been proven to be more effective a timproving overall comprehe nsion than the non-subtitled movie. Movie subtitles may offer a new pathway for language learning and understanding; the use of movie subtitles proves to be more successful than the non-subtitled movies in enhancing overall understanding. According to Faqe (2017), watching films with English subtitles will enhance the learning of vocabulary and enable learners to gain vocabulary. It also helps learn about English words, grammar, idioms, and new slang.

Habit is a routine behavior that is repeated regularly and tends to happen without realizing it. According to Riandi (2016), habits are activities or attitudes that exist in man both physically and mentally by doing it repeatedly and in the long term. A habit is an eventor experience in life that is repeated over and over, from time to time, from year to year.

The habit of watching movies provide opportunities to studylanguage about vocabulary. Moreover, students should have a scheduleforit.Inordertotheycangetnewvocabularyandfindmuchinforma tion about grammar to help language skill. Sometimes they alsowillfindproblemswiththestructure,anddifficultnewvocabularybase donthedialoguebythenativespeaker.Then,theycanlookforthe solution to the problems by asking the teacher or looking for theotherreferent.

Habituation is a type of non-associative learning in which theprobabilityofabehavioralresponsedecreaseswithtimewhena

stimulus is repeated. Larsen, Feerman, & Anderson (2013) state thatlanguagelearningisahabit-

According to Syafi'i (2013), there was a positive effect of habitwatching English movies on students' vocabulary mastery. In addition,a study conducted by Dhamarullah (2016) analyzed the relationshipbetween movie-watching activity and listening skills. Found out thatthestudydisplayednegativerelationshipbetweenstudents'movie-watchingactivity andtheirlisteningskills.

The researcher is interested to choose SMP Muhammadiyah 1Palembang as an object of this research because the researcher hasdone PLP in SMP Muhammadiyah 1 Palembang and interviewed theteacher of English SMP Muhammadiyah 1 Palembang. The result wasshowed that the students had lack of vocabulary mastery and not ableto identify word meanings. Meanwhile, the teachers did not used thegoodmedia available.
